Color was chief 1963 goal with special attention to green and lavender or pink. ^(Hood) Luxury lace was used extensively - - also a Hall pink seedling of Rare China or Veiled Beauty type. Grand lady, Sadie and Miss Jessie were used also. Small flowered, low growing varieties - - the continuing overall interest - - went on. There was much use of the 0 43 cross, and of others with 57-2 cross in background.

Oklahoma Nell = Strutter (Branch) x 57-2C
57-2C = Picture (Lester) x Ringlets (Krasa)
Jest = 57-2C x Fancywork (Branch)

Many attractive seedlings, some with little branching. Substance generally heavy. Selections made in 1966 and numbered, then divided and lined out. Additional selections made in 1967 but these were left in place due to '68 Convention.
