This cross was made in an effort to get small flowers in the illusioz, near-white, color of 59-47E. Since the latter is short on bud count and has mediocre branching, it has never been named. There was limited bloom by 1966 on all but one plant. This had three scapes -- showed definite promise. All four plants were kept for more study.

Light creamy yellow. All segments ruffled. 20-25 buds. (Rather) high branching in 1966 (3 way). Open very late. Very heat resistant.

1967- 30 buds.

40-48" high, 4 way branching. Long blooming. Much used in crossing. Very nice flowers and plant.

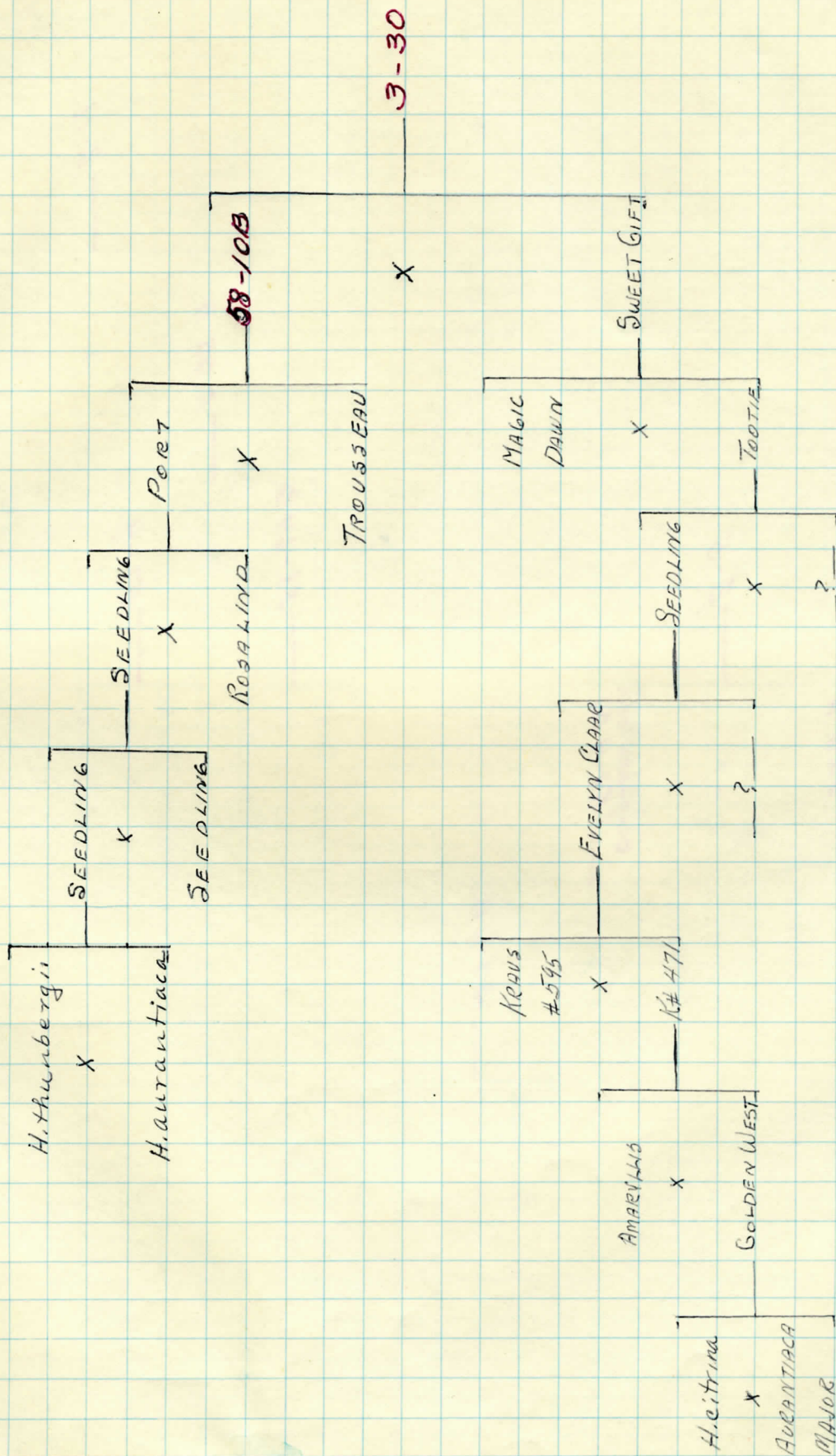

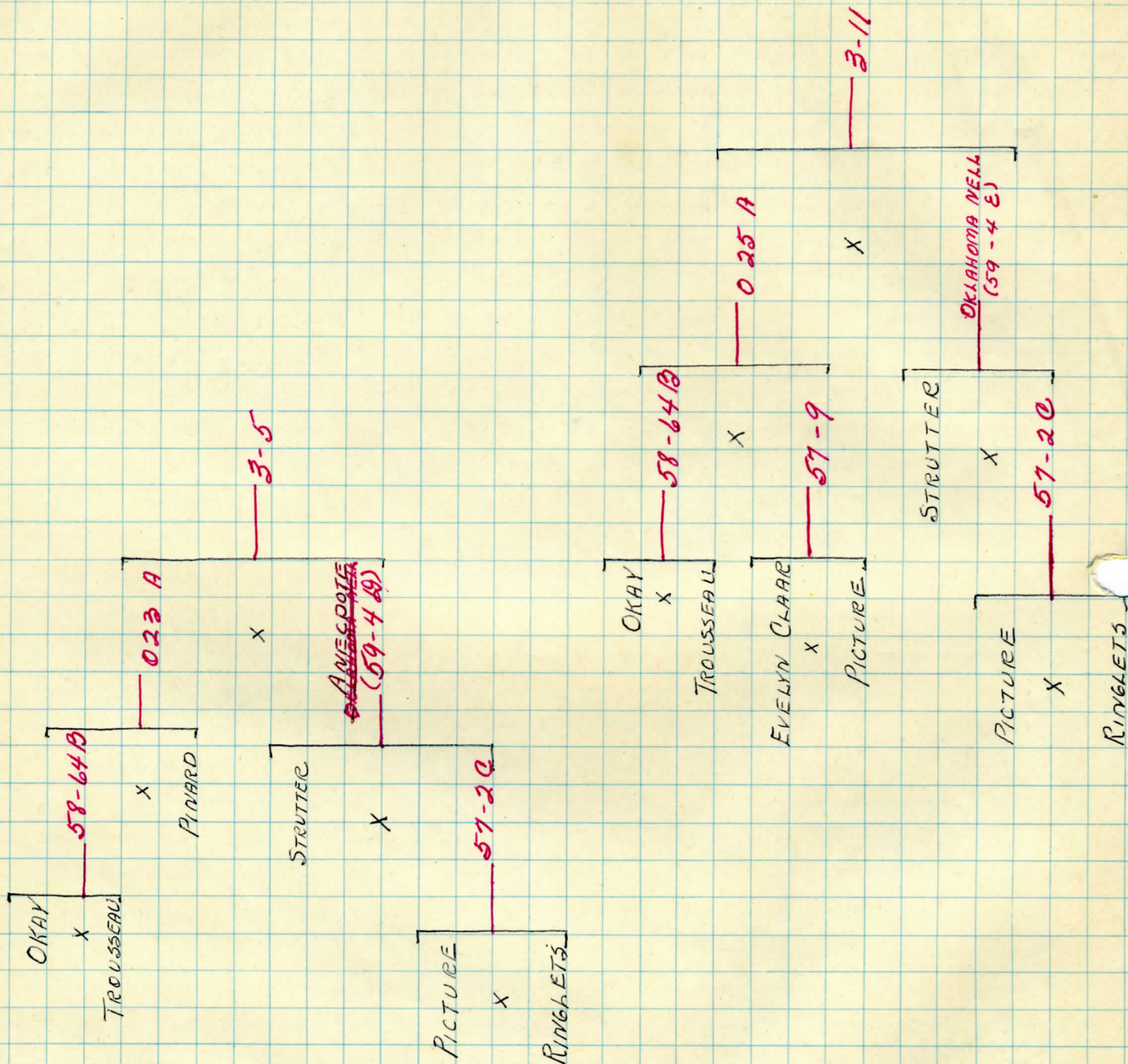
